Crowd-voting open for the IFSEC Future of Security Competition

Inaugural IFSEC competition invites the public to identify most innovative security solutions

London, 11 May 2011:

Crowd-voting is open for the first-ever IFSEC Future of Security Competition. The nine finalists have prepared 90-second long pitches, available through a dedicated [crowd-voting website](#) powered by OmniCompete. Everyone is eligible to vote once, but must first register (cost-free) with OmniCompete. Public votes will be accepted until 17th May 2011, and will count towards the final evaluation.

Sponsored by prominent defence contractor Raytheon, the IFSEC competition is seeking innovative commercial security solutions from individuals, groups and companies with an annual turnover below €50M. This year's finalists are 2020 Imaging, Audio Analytic, BriefCam, BRS Labs, Inquisitive Systems, iOmniscient, OmniPerception, ScanTech Identification Beam Systems and Whitenoise Laboratories. All pitches can be viewed and voted on at www.omnicompete.com/ifsec.

The competition precedes the annual IFSEC exposition, renowned as the world's leading annual security event. Finalists will pitch their products live to expert judges and an audience on 17th May at IFSEC 2011 in Birmingham, UK. The judges will add their evaluations to the public vote in order to determine the winning team, who will be awarded \$10,000 and top-level industry mentorship.
